Getting to Gullane

Gullane is located along the East Lothian coastline around a 40-minute drive from Edinburgh city centre and 50 minutes from Edinburgh airport. There are not many courses that you drive through to get to, but that is what you will do as you drive along the A198 to reach the golf club located on the west of Gullane Village.

The nearest train station is Drem which is 4 miles away and is served by the North Berwick line from Edinburgh Waverley.

If you need transport from Drem then please arrange in advance as there is no local taxi rank or Uber available.

Arrival & Parking

As you approach Gullane from the west, turn right for Gullane No.2 and Gullane No.3 and park in front of The Links which is the white with the red roof.

The Links has changing rooms for men and women with lockers and showers for use during your visit.

Checking-In

Please check in for your round 30 minutes in advance at the Pro Shop located in The Links. They can organise club and trolley hire available which should be booked in advance.

When you are ready to play, please check in with the Starter located between the first tees for Gullane No.2 and Gullane No.3.

The putting green and chipping area is located by The Links. Beyond that is the Toptracer practice range and complimentary balls for visitors with a tee time are available from the Starter or The Links Pro Shop.



Food & Beverage

The Links offers a wide range of menu choices from a delicious golfer's breakfast, light lunches or main meals using locally sourced products. The bar features a bright open seating area with large screen TVs and a patio area for eating outdoors when the sun is shining. Come and enjoy our hospitality and relax and enjoy the views over the Gullane links to the Lammermuir Hills behind.

Caddies

Our informative and friendly caddies are available any day on any course. Caddy fees are £65 plus gratuity and can be paid direct to the caddy on the day. All of our caddies are self-employed and depend on this income for a living, so in the unlikely event of a caddy being cancelled less than 24 hours before play then the booking fee would still be payable.

The player must introduce themselves to the Starter ahead of being introduced to the caddy. Caddies are only allocated to one player and forecaddies are not permitted.

Rental Items

The Pro Shop has a wide range of items to hire for your round including club hire, push trolleys and electric trolleys. Each player must have their own set of clubs.

Ride-on motorised buggies are available to hire for those who can provide a medical certificate in advance. The use of personal motorised buggies is prohibited.

Dress Code

Golfing attire is required for all players on and off the course. Clothing that may have endured the rigours of golfing, for example wet or muddy garments, must be changed out of before entering any lounge, bar or dining areas.

Coats, hats and other outdoor clothing should be left in changing rooms. For the avoidance of doubt, denim jeans, t-shirts, cargo or combat trousers/shorts, tracksuits, rugby and football shirts, flip-flops or open toed sandals are not permitted on the course or in the Clubhouse at any time.

Pace Of Play

Gullane is renowned for ready golf and its quick pace of play. We would encourage our guests to join our members in allowing quicker matches to play through so everyone can enjoy their round at Gullane at their own pace.

On Course Toilets

There are on-course toilets on each course and the Starter will advise of the location and entry codes when you check in.

Alcoholic Drinks

Alcoholic drinks are not permitted on the golf course and anyone found in possession of alcohol will be removed from the course.

Liability

Secretaries, organisers and visiting golfers should ensure that they are aware of the Club rules prior to play. Visitors, their vehicles, any clothing and equipment are on Gullane Golf Club property at their own risk. Gullane Golf Club reserves the right at its absolute discretion to refuse entry or remove any person behaving in an inappropriate manner on the course or in the clubhouses.
